This program is limited to 15 RMMS families in grades K-2 Puentes Program, so please sign up using the link in the newsletter.

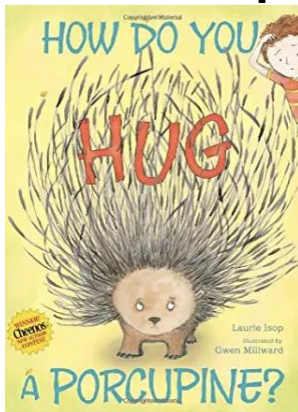

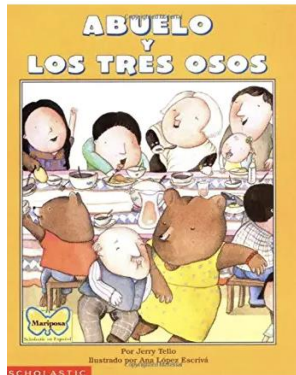
